Guideline for the Release Process of the Drafts

Dear Sir or Madam,

You are participating in our draft-system for ChemDoc24. To this end, you will be emailed a link whenever a file is uploaded to our release platform (see figure below). Via this link you can either directly access our <u>release</u> platform or directly view the draft file. Upon receipt of the email, you will have **14 calendar days** to view and release the draft of your file. After this period your file will automatically be released and forwarded to the ChemDoc24 platform.




When you click on the <u>direct link to the file</u>, you can directly view the selected file. This file is identified as "DRAFT" (see picture on the right).

You can then check whether the safety data sheet, label, etc. were created correctly or whether changes need to be made to the draft.




To **release** or **reject** the file, you must log on to the **release platform** of ChemDoch24. For this, follow the link to the <u>release</u> platform provided in the email (see picture below).




Log on with your access data.




Under **Drafts** you can see all <u>files still to be released</u> and all <u>previously rejected files</u>. Open the relevant file and click on **Release/Rejection**.



If the safety data sheet, label, etc. are <u>complete</u> and <u>correct</u>, then select "**Release**" from the selection field on the right, check "**Confirm Action!**" and click on "**Submit**". The released file is then automatically saved in the ChemDoc24 system and can be accessed there, so long as no updated version is created.



If the safety data sheet, label, etc. are <u>incomplete</u> and <u>incorrect</u>, then select "**Rejection**" from the selection field on the right, and specify in the text field "**Note/Message/Comment**" the items that need to be edited by the person responsible for your file. Subsequently check "**Confirm Action!**" and click on "**Submit**".



The person responsible for your file will then receive an email with the text to be edited. The rejected file is automatically saved in the list of "**Rejected Files**" and you receive a new **email for release** as soon as new draft has been created.

Please note that each draft is **valid for only 14 calendar days** and will **automatically be released** after this period.
